Now in its 8th year, the Consilio Manuque Scholarship programme has found its niche.

For the first five years of the scholarship, thanks to alumni support, we were able to award two Consilio Manuque Scholarships per academic year.

Since 2022, increased alumni support has allowed us to expand this to five scholarships annually - a number we hope to sustain in the years ahead. Our scholars consistently tell us that this support makes a real difference - helping them afford college life, easing financial pressure, and giving them the freedom to focus on their studies without added stress.

Beyond the financial benefit, being awarded a merit-based scholarship instils a deep sense of confidence and empowerment. It's a recognition of our students' potential and a powerful encouragement as they continue their journey with us here at RCSI.

In 2024, with support from alumni, we were able to award five students with a Consilio Manuque Scholarship.


THE GIFT OF TIME
